

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For Specialist Knowledge

L2 Certificate in Introduction to Autistic Spectrum Conditions (RQF)

- A fantastic in-depth course giving learners the knowledge and understanding they need to better support people with Autism

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IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

PLEASE NOTE:

- All learners will need to have access to a Laptop/PC/Tablet and have stable internet connection.
- All workbooks will be able to be completed electronically (via Word or Editable PDF).
- Learners will need to have a good working understanding of English.

FUNDING AND INVOICING

- When a learner completes their training, we will send all the necessary info to you and your local Workforce Development Fund (WDF) partnership needed to make a claim through Skills for Care. Skills for Care then pay the partnership, who in turn pays your organisation.
- Skills for Care will not allow a partnership to pay us directly as a training provider, which is why we also invoice you at the same time as we send over the WDF claims information. For the training you are doing with us through WDF funding, our invoice is for the same amount as the claim value normally you will have had the money from Skills for Care via the partnership before you need to pay our invoice within our 40-day terms (with the exception of the Leading Change Improving Care course where due to the length of the course we charge the WDF funding value upfront at the booking stage).
- Social Works Ltd use Lloyds Invoice Financing to factor our invoices and when we invoice, they will be in touch to explain how they work.
- We cannot be held liable for any funding changes made with respect to the Workforce Development Fund by Skills for Care. All information above is correct at time of writing.

**Please note the 4 days funded training covers all the Care Certificate Knowledge Standards except Basic Life Support, which employers normally do in-house.
