Practice education development case studies 2024

- Pre-registration healthcare students have recently started a non-clinical corporate placement with CNWL.
- Final year nursing students undertake a four-week rotational placement using a blended learning model, comprising of experience in information governance, risk, safety and safeguarding, incident management, performance, improvement and the serious incident teams.
- The placement has an over-arching theme of quality improvement that enables students to undertake project work that contributes to a culture of continuous learning within the organisation.
- Studying alongside their biomedical counterparts, preregistration students are being offered a blend of two-day clinical placements in GP practices within the Hillingdon Confederation in addition to two days of virtual learning and a day working within the corporate team of the confederation leading to a student-led project.
- Brunel University London were one of the first universities to be approached by Frimley Health to support the development of a new non-clinical multiprofessional leadership placement.
- Designed for any pre-registration healthcare student, the placement provides a complete leadership training and development package that focuses on self-assessment, coaching and peer-to-peer learning opportunities.
